

17. Explain how Noah warned the people to repent but they ignored him, and God destroyed them with a flood.
18. Explain how Abraham warned the city of Sodom (sodomy, sodomites) to repent but they ignored him, and God destroyed the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah (Gnnrh, gonnoreah) with a fire of sulfur from the sky.
19. Explain how Moses (name meaning 'drawn on water') warned the nation of Egypt to repent but they ignored him; and God destroyed Egypt with plagues, including hail, and a fiery wind.
20. In Isaiah we read: "I am God, there is no other; I am God, there is none like me. At the beginning I declared the outcome; from of old, things not yet done. I say my plan shall stand, I accomplish my every desire... Yes, I have spoken, I will accomplish it; I have planned it, and I will do it."

Isaiah 46:8-11

21. "Things of the past I declared long ago, they went forth from my mouth, I announced them; then suddenly I took action and they came to be." Isaiah 48:3

22. "This day the LORD, your God, is commanding you to obey these statutes and ordinances. Be careful, then, to observe them with your whole heart and with your whole being. Today you have accepted the LORD's agreement ... And today the LORD has accepted your agreement..." Deuteronomy 26:16-19. Explain why this is Contract (covenant) language of "offer and acceptance" to the Ten Commandments and all God's laws in order to receive God's promised blessings.
23. "Be careful not to forget the LORD, your God, by failing to keep his commandments and ordinances and statutes which I enjoin on you today ... But if you do forget the LORD, your God, and go after other gods, serving and bowing to them, I bear witness to you this day that you will perish utterly. Like the nations which the LORD destroys before you, so shall you too perish for not listening to the voice of the LORD, your God." Deuteronomy 8:11-20 Explain how God's Covenant (contract) of Commandments promises God will destroy any nation that disobeys his Ten Commands. This same truth was related to Noah, Abraham, Moses, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Elijah, Ezekiel and all the Lord's prophets.

24. "I am the LORD, your God, teaching you how to prevail, leading you on the way you should go. If only you would obey my commandments, your peace would be like a river... your descendants like the sand..." *Isaiah 48:17-19*
25. "Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel: Cursed be anyone who does not obey the words of this covenant (contract), which I commanded your ancestors the day I brought them up out of the land of Egypt... Listen to my voice and do all that I command you. ... But they did not listen or obey... Therefore, thus says the LORD: See, I am bringing upon them a disaster they cannot escape." *Jeremiah 11:1-11*
26. "All nations will gather together to honor the name of the LORD at Jerusalem, and they will no longer stubbornly follow their wicked heart." *Jeremiah 3:17* "Or else my anger will break out like fire, and burn so that no one can quench it, because of your evil deeds." *Jeremiah 4:4* "The LORD has indeed rejected and cast off the generation that draws down his wrath." *Jeremiah 7:26-29*
27. "I will repay them double for their crimes and their sin because they profaned my land... and filled my heritage with their abominations." *Jeremiah 16:11-18*

28. "Look! The storm of the Lord! His wrath breaks out in a whirling storm that burst upon the heads of the wicked." Jeremiah 30:23-24
29. "The Lord's fire came down and devoured the burnt offering, wood, stones, and dust, and lapped up the water in the trench."

30. "But as for those whose hearts are devoted to their atrocities and abominations, I will bring their conduct down upon their heads."

34. "[Israel], your younger sister was Sodom (Sodomites, sodomy) and her daughters, south of you. Not only did you walk in their ways and act as abominably as they did (homosexuality, orgies, abortion, contraceptives), but in a very short time you became more corrupt in all your ways than they were. ... I swear that your sister Sodom with her daughters have done the things you and your daughters have done! ... they became arrogant and committed abominations before me; then as you have seen, I destroyed them." Ezekiel 16:46-50

35. "For all life is mine; the life of the parent is like the life of the child, both are mine. Only the one who sins shall die." Ezekiel 18:4

36. "I let them become defiled by their offerings, by having them make a fiery offering of every womb's firstborn, in order to ruin them so that they might know that I am the LORD ... Just as I entered into judgment with your ancestors in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so will I enter into judgment with you ... Thus I will make you pass under the staff and will impose on you the terms of the covenant ... I am the LORD." Ezekiel 20:13-38

37. "I formed you, and set you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations,
... I am the LORD, LORD is my name; ... See, the earlier things have come to pass, new ones I now declare; Before they spring forth I announce them to you."

38. "I formed you and set you as a covenant for the people, to restore the land." Isaiah 49:8

39. "Thus says the LORD who formed you, your help, who formed you from the womb: ... I am the first, I am the last; there is no God but me."

Isaiah 44:2,6.

40. "Before birth the LORD called me, from my mother's womb he gave me my name. ... Thus says the LORD: ... I formed you and set you as a covenant for the people, To restore the land..."

Isaiah 49:1,8-11.

41. Explain why God is the Father (Mother, having a maternal Name shape as Nature) of all children in the womb. This is true from the first moment of conception at fertilization

1. It is an absolute rule of the law of physics that "only one thing can occupy a space at any time."
2. Explain why God occupies the full space in which God exists.
3. Explain why if something other than God were to occupy that space, God would cease to exist. This is because only one thing can occupy a single space.
4. Because of this principle of law, God must animate us in God's mind to mental image His designs for electrons, molecules, earth, and "creatures."
5. All is animation in the Mind of God.
6. God Authors the existence of all motion and thoughts.

7. God authors (writes, scripts, draws) the Math (Natr; Nature) of all we see. God is that intimate in the details of all creation
8. God alone exists. All else is authored by God, animations in the Mind of God.
9. Because of this, nothing can be "One in being with God."
10. There is no "trinity."
11. A nation exists because God has authored it.
12. God warns that any nation that forgets God will eventually be "destroyed by God."
13. All nations owe obedience to God's Ten Commandments and thanks giving to God.

4. Jeremiah the prophet wrote: "I know, Lord, that no one chooses their way, Nor determines their course nor directs their own step." Jeremiah 10:23

Explain how that is the prophet's knowledge that God authors all existence. God animates all motion and thoughts.

5. Yet God draws some persons to sin, which is only to prove God's Ten Commandments right and trustworthy, because in the end God will draw that good always triumphs over evil. For example: God's law forbids premarital sex. When that law is disobeyed, the world spirals downward into the foreseeable consequences of that sin, which are contraception, which leads to adultery and abortion (murder), then cannibalism—Hence, the destruction of marriage and the ruin of society. Only obedience to God's commands can restore the broken society. Explain this fact.

16. In addition, God warns through all the Biblical prophets that "any nation that does not return to Obedience of all God's commandments, will be destroyed."
