

1. "If only you would attend to my commandments, your peace would be like a river..."  
Isaiah 48:17-19
2. "They shall not hunger or thirst; nor shall scorching wind or sun strike them." Isaiah 49:10  
"The sun will not strike you by day, nor the moon by night." Psalm 121
3. "For thus says the LORD, The creator of the heavens, who is God, The designer and maker of earth who established it, Not as an empty waste did he create it, but designing it to be lived in: I am the LORD, and there is no other.... Turn to me and be safe, all you ends of the earth, for I am God; there is no other!" Isaiah 45:18-22.
4. "The LORD is my shepherd; there is nothing I lack. In green pastures he makes me lie down; to still waters he leads me;... He guides me along right paths for his name sake."  
Psalm 23:1-3.
5. "Yet he saved them for his name's sake to make his power known. He roared at the Red Sea and it dried up. He lead them through the deep as through a desert. He rescued them from hostile hands, freed from the power of the enemy. The waters covered their oppressors; not one of them survived." Psalm 106:8-12.

6. "My help comes from the LORD, the maker of heaven and earth." Psalm 121:2.
7. "For you make me jubilant, LORD, by your deeds; at the works of your hands I shout for joy." Psalm 92:5
8. "You make the grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people's work to bring forth food from the earth." Psalm 104:14
9. "Those trusting in the LORD are like Mount Zion, unshakable, forever enduring.... The Scepter of the wicked will not prevail... Do good, LORD, to the good, to those who are upright of heart. But those who turn aside to crooked ways may the LORD send down with the evildoers." Psalm 125:1-5
10. Explain how God authors (animates, draws) good people to know God's Bounty, shepherding the just and true.
11. But the evil persons God authors (animates, draws) them "handed over to their sinful passions, deceptions, and lies."
12. "But the house of Isreal rebelled against me in the wilderness. They did not observe my statutes, and they rejected my ordinances that bring life ~~to~~ those who keep them....

Then I said to their children in the wilderness:  
Do not follow the statutes of your parents.  
Do not keep their ordinances. Do not defile  
yourselves with their idols. I am the LORD,  
your God: follow my statutes and be  
careful to observe my ordinances... But  
their children rebelled against me... Therefore  
I gave them statutes that were not good,  
and ordinances through which they could  
not have life. I let them become defiled  
by their offerings, by having them make a  
fiery offering of every womb's firstborn, in  
order to ruin them so that they might  
know that I am the LORD." Ezekiel 20:13-38

13. Explain why only God's statutes and ordinances are just and safely for the nation; while any people or nation that try to substitute their own preferred statutes and ordinances, i.e., abortion, or homosexuality, will be "handed over" to those sins and will be "ruined" and "destroyed."
14. Instead of a shepherd, to the wicked God is a "Tester" and "deceiver" because they do not want His laws. "As for the prophet, if he speaks deceiving words, I the LORD am the one who deceives that prophet." Ezekiel 14:9

15. God will not be altered by human complaints against His every letter of His commandments. "Thus says the LORD God: Have you come to consult me? As I live, I will not allow myself to be consulted by you!" Ezekiel 20:2-3
17. Those who teach 'man's laws' instead of God's laws, God calls them 'false-shepherds.'
18. "Better to take refuge in the LORD than to put one's trust in mortals. Better to take refuge in the LORD than to put one's trust in princes." Psalm 118:8-9
19. As for those who dare hide behind 'man's laws' instead of God's laws, God warns: "They have followed false-shepherds into the abyss." "Look! I am coming against these shepherds... I will judge between one sheep and another..." Ezekiel 34:2-25 "Beware! I am making all the inhabitants of this land drunk... the priests and prophets, and all the inhabitants... I will smash them against each other... showing no compassion, I will neither spare nor pity, but I will destroy them."

Jeremiah 12:13-14

20. God warned He would author (animate, write, draw) entire nations to be handed over to sinful "confusion, dumbfoundedness, stupor." See above, "Beware! I am making all the inhabitants of this land drunk." Jeremiah 12:13-14.
- "But the LORD is with me, like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not prevail. In their failure they will be put to utter shame, to lasting, unforgettable confusion." Jeremiah 20:11-13

21. "Had they stood council, they would have proclaimed my words to my people, They would have brought them back from their evil ways and from their wicked deeds. Am I a God near at hand only... and not a God far off? Can anyone hide in secret without me seeing them? Do I not fill heaven and earth?... let those who have my word speak my word truthfully! ... Yes, I am against the prophets... those who compose their own speeches and call them oracles... those who lead my people astray by recounting their reckless lies."

22. God rewards those humble of heart who accept and obey God's laws, whether popular or not. "Whether we like it or not, we will obey the command of the LORD, our God... so that

it may go well with us for obeying the command of the LORD, our God."

Jeremiah 42:1-6

23. As for cults of satanism such as the 'Obelisk' 'temple of Lodges' God warned: "He shall smash the obelisk at the Temple of the Sun in the land of Egypt and destroy with fire the temples of the Egyptian gods."

24. As for that cult's genital 'paranormal' that God tested them with in the Obelisk Scam, God warned: "You served as a prostitute with the Egyptians, your big-membered neighbors, and multiplied your prostitutions to provoke me... because you gave the life-blood of your children to them, therefore,... 27. Explain why the only hope for lasting peace and God's Bounty to be restored is for all to obey God's commandments.

28. "At one moment I may decree concerning a nation or kingdom that I will uproot and tear down and destroy it; but if that nation against whom I have decreed turns from its evil, then I will have a change of heart regarding the evil which I have decreed. At another moment, I may decree concerning a nation or kingdom that I will build up and plant it; but if that nation does what is evil in my eyes, refuses to obey my voice, then I will have a change of heart regarding the good which I planned to bless it." Jeremiah 18:7-10. "Thus says the LORD God: Return, turn away from your idols; from all your abominations, turn your faces. For, if anyone... keeps their idols in their hearts, setting the stumbling block of their sin before them... I will set my

face against them and make them a sign and a byword, and cut them off from the midst of my people." Ezekiel 14:6-8

"When the just ~~turn~~ turn away from justice and do what is wrong, they shall die for it.

When the wicked turn away from wickedness and do what is right and just, because of this they shall live." Ezekiel 33:18-19

29. Explain why every true shepherd will insist on all of God's laws, thus "making straight the way of the LORD." "A voice proclaims: In the wilderness prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God! Every valley shall be lifted up, every mountain hill made low; The rugged land shall be a plain, the rough country, a broad valley. Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken." Isaiah 40:3-5

30. "In place of the thornbush, the cypress shall grow, instead of nettles, the myrtle."
