

11. "You shall not kill." Exodus 20:13;  
Deuteronomy 5:17 Explain why when  
God forms a child in the womb at  
Conception at fertilization, that no  
one has a right to murder that child!
12. Explain who defines when a child is  
conceived (conceptus), God, or woman!
13. Explain who defines 'murder' God, or  
woman!
14. "For all life is mine; the life of the  
child is equal to (like) the life of the  
mother, both are mine. Only the  
one who sins shall die." Ezekiel 18:4  
Explain why God favors the life of the  
unborn innocent child over the life  
of the mother.
15. "You have profaned me among my people...  
killing those who should not be killed, and  
keeping alive those who should not live,  
lying to my people, who listen to lies."  
Ezekiel 13:19
16. Explain why "Pro Life" means you can be for  
rational "death penalties" but not allow  
abortion.

17. "An eye for an eye, tooth for tooth, life for life." Explain why God's law requires proportionality between a crime and the punishment.

18. "Whoever takes the life of any human being shall be put to death.... Anyone who inflicts permanent injury on his or her neighbor shall receive the same in return: fracture for fracture, eye for eye, tooth for tooth. The same injury that one gives another shall be inflicted in return.... but whoever takes a human life shall be put to death."

Leviticus 24:17-21.

19. You may not like capital punishment, but you must agree that the message in the above scripture text is that God require a severity of punishment that is equal to (commensurate with) the crime.

20. God also decreed other sins (crimes against natural law) deserve the death penalty, including homosexuality:

"You shall not lay with another male as with a woman; such a thing is an abomination." Leviticus 18:22. "If a man lays with a male as with a woman, they shall be put to death."

Leviticus 20:13.

21. God decreed other sins (crimes against natural law) did not deserve the death penalty, but instead to "cut them off from the community;" this included "incest." "If a man marries his sister, his father's daughter or his mother's daughter, and they have intercourse with each other, that is disgraceful: they shall be publicly cut off from the people,"

Leviticus 20:17

22. "Observe my statutes and be careful to keep my ordinances, so that you will dwell securely in the land." "Do not conform to the customs of the nations whom I am driving out of your way, because of all these things that they have done have filled me with disgust for them."

Leviticus 20:22-23; 25:18

23. "Be careful to observe all my statutes and all my decrees; otherwise the land where I am bringing you to dwell will vomit you out."

Leviticus 20:22

24. "Do not make idols for yourself (yourselves). . . . If you live in accordance with my statutes and are careful to obey my commandments, I will give you your rains in due season, so that the land will yield its crops, and the trees their fruit... Ever present in your midst, I will be your God.

and you will be my people. I, the LORD, am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt to be their slaves no more, breaking the bars of your yoke and making you walk erect."

Leviticus 26:1-13

25. Explain why whenever someone calls God's laws 'crazy,' 'mean,' 'unjust,' 'barbarism,' 'old fashioned nonsense,' - they are making an idol in place of the real God of Israel. See above.
26. We have proved God is lone God, and therefore was alone in the beginning. We proved God exist alone in the space God occupies. We proved therefore God has to mental image animate (Author) all electrons, molecules, earth and "creatures." No one has real "free will" other than God! We have copyright "simulated free will," much like artificial intelligence has a math, nature, a program that dictates what God animates (draws) it do.
27. We proved also there cannot exist a "trinity." God is alone.
28. Explain why anything Jesus taught cannot

be used to alter or overturn any letter of God's original Laws given to Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses, Elijah, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, or any of the trustworthy prophets.

29. Explain why Jesus is a "hoax deity."
30. Explain why the cross is an idol, and a wooden carving people misused to alter God's laws — they sought to forgive sins God requires punishment for. They dared say 'the cross set them free from God's law,' and thus erected that idol in the sanctuary in place of God and His original laws.
31. Explain how there cannot exist any 'spirits' nor any 'spiritual heaven.' Rather, God has promised to make "a new earth" for us. Explain how there cannot exist both a "heaven" and a "new Earth"!
32. Explain how Jesus cannot save you from God's true laws.
33. Who are you to say to the Potter that His laws are 'not right' or 'unfair'?
34. Do you want God; or an idol.

1. "Yet, LORD, you are our father; we are the clay and you our potter: we are all the work of your hand." Isaiah 64:7 Explain how we are not literally 'clay' nor does God create as a 'potter' — Rather, God creates by animation (authoring, writing, drawing) in God's Mind. Explain how 'potter' and 'clay' is merely poetic.
2. "Woe to anyone who contends with their Maker; a potsherd among potsherds of the earth! Shall the clay say to the potter, 'What are you doing?'" Isaiah 45:9
3. "You say, 'The LORD's way is not fair!' Hear now, house of Israel: Is it my way that is unfair? Are not your ways unfair?" Ezekiel 18:25
4. "But on that day... my fury will flare up in my anger, and in my jealousy, with fiery wrath, I swear on that day there will be a great earthquake in the land of Israel. Before me will tremble... everyone on the face of the earth. Mountains will be overturned, terraces will collapse, and every wall will fall to the ground.... I will execute judgment on him: disease and bloodshed; flooding rain and hailstones, fire and brimstone,

I will rain down on him, on his troops and on the many nations with him. And so I will show my greatness and holiness and make myself known in the sight of many nations." Ezekiel 38:18-23.

5. "It was I who made the earth, human being and beast on the face of the earth, by my great power, with my outstretched arm.... In the past, the prophets who came before you and prophesied war, disaster, and pestilence against many lands and mighty kingdoms. But the prophets who prophesied peace is recognized as the prophet who the LORD has truly sent only when his word comes to pass." Jeremiah 27:4-5; 28:7-9 Explain how the people rejected true prophets who foretold destructions, punishments, wrath, hail, whirlwinds, floods, wars, fire and brimstone; ~~but~~ yet the people love false prophets of 'peace and gentleness'!
6. "Though I repeatedly sent you all my servants the prophets, saying: 'You must not commit this abominable deed I hate,' they did not listen or incline their ears in order to turn from their evil... Therefore the fury of my anger poured forth and kindled fire... to turn them into ruined wasteland they are

to day... They have not followed my law and my statutes that I set before you and your ancestors." Jeremiah 44:4-10

7. "They sacrificed to demons their own sons and daughters, shedding innocent blood, the blood of their own sons and daughters, whom they sacrificed to the idols (false gods) of Canaan, desecrating the land with bloodshed. They defiled themselves by their actions, became adulterers by their conduct. So the LORD grew angry ... He handed them over to the nations, and their adversaries ruled over them." Psalm 106:37-41.
8. "You formed my inmost being; You knit me in my mother's womb." Psalm 139:13.
9. "You have given them the command to obey your precepts with care... Open my eyes to see clearly the wonders of your law... Give me understanding to keep your law, to observe it with all my heart. Lead me in the path of your commandments, for that is my delight... Your hands made and fashioned me; give me understanding to learn your commandments."
